Harry A Dossin went home to his Father God and his Savior Jesus on January 19, 2018. He passed away peacefully in his sleep at his daughter's house.

Harry, beloved of his family, friends, and caregivers, was born April 10, 1926 in Norwalk, Ohio to Guido Albert Dossin and Helen Axelia Johnson Dossin. He graduated from Norwalk High School in 1944. He was a hero of WWII (Bronze Star) fighting with the 27th Regiment, 25th Infantry Division, US Army. After the war, he went to pilot school, and airframe and power plant training at Dallas Aviation School, Love Field, Dallas, Texas. This training was put to use in a 36-year career at what is now the Lockheed-Martin plant in Fort Worth, TX, retiring from General Dynamics in 1986. His hobbies included tennis, woodworking, photography, and travel.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his siblings.
